246 **COUNCIL BANK MANDATE**

The Council received and considered the joint report of the Town Clerk/C.E.O & Responsible Financial Officer (RFO) regarding the bank mandate of the Council following ordinary elections.

In line with financial regulations, the Council was required to appoint Councillor signatories for all payments over £5,000. The same principle applied to transactions relating to surplus funds held in the CCLA Public Sector Deposit Fund and the Local Authorities Property Fund.

For business continuity purposes the Council also agreed two Councillors should be jointly appointed to deal with banking matters in the absence of the Town Clerk, Deputy Town Clerk, and RFO.

- 3. That, the same above Members be appointed as signatories on funds held in the CCLA Public Sector Deposit Fund and Local Authorities Property Fund and,
- 4. That, Councillors R Smith and J Doughty be given joint authority to deal with matters relating to the bank in the absence of the Town Clerk, Deputy Town Clerk and RFO.
