Background

The purpose of this report is to update Councillors about the Health and safety status across all of Witney Town Council's facilities and provide an update on vandalism since the last meeting.

Current Situation

Compliance

All 6 monthly alarm testing has been completed over sites managed by Witney Town Council. The gas safety check and boiler servicing have been completed at the Corn Exchange with remedial works due to be completed on the 6th of October.

Health and Safety

Members of the maintenance team were found to not be wearing protective face wear during hedge-cutting duties. After review, this was found that the protective glasses were fogging up. All members of the works team have now been issued with antifog protective eyewear.

Vandalism

15/09/23 - Plant pot missing from grave plot reported. The grave owner has been advised that items are left at the owner's risk and to report it on 101.

25/09/23 - Burwell Goal net supports vandalised. Repairs have been made but the posts will have to be replaced after the 2023-24 season.

20/09/23 - Fishing sign vandalised, repaired.

26/09/23 Anti-social behaviour in the Corn Exchange, staff verbally abused, and soap was sprayed all over the toilets. Wall-mounted soap dispensers have been ordered and the incident has been reported to TVP.

Environmental impact
