## Projects In Progress:

Christmas Lights Display	In process of evaluating tenders for the 2024-26 lights display & real Christmas Trees. Current years budget is £55,000 including infrastructure.
Children & Young People	A budget of £40,000 is set aside for the continuation of detached youth work in 24/25.
Schools In Bloom	Provision of wheelbarrows, compost, and grant to plant according to theme. Judging part of Council's entry into Witney Carnival.
50 <sup>th</sup> Anniversary WTC	Programme of events taking place throughout 2024 to mark 50 <sup>th</sup> Anniversary. Budget £5k
D-Day 80 <sup>th</sup> Anniversary	Events taking place on 6 <sup>th</sup> June 2024 – agreed via working party. Budget £1,500.
Blue Plaque	Looking to refurbish the Blue Plaques on Town Hall and Buttercross buildings.
QE Sundial Legacy	Installation Unterhaching Park – issues with suitability of fixing sundial to base. Awaiting Officer solution.
WOCT Bus Grant	Continuation of the Council's commitment to the community bus service grant increased to £23,500 in 2024.
WTC Website	Currently re-mapping website – using in-house resource.

## Projects in Preparation Pool/Part or Unfunded:

Welch Way Planters	The Council has been putting £2,000 aside each year for 5 years to install a new concrete planter in 2024/25.
Bus Shelters	Request for Bus Shelter on Wood Green, Woodstock Road – no budget. Any unspent budget from bus shelter maintenance a/c 4035/402 is transferred into the Infrastructure EMR.
Defibrillator	Within the revenue budget there is an expenditure code 4166/402 for defibrillator expenditure – and unspent budget is transferred over into the EMR in order to cover off future replacements.
Graffiti Art Project	New Skate Park – see report of the Project Officer at later agenda item.
Bins/Benches	Within the Open Spaces Strategy IS5 – audit carried out on the state of bins, benches etc. Officers to prioritise and draw up a replacement programme, fund via Infrastructure EMR a/c 369 – capital code 4931/800.
St Mary's Church Clock	Request from Bell Captain to make the clock and Carillion digital – approx. cost £10k
