Thanks for your email and for drawing our attention to the recent vandalism problems in Witney. We have noted the potential hot spots and will be particularly vigilant from now on in this area.

Guy and I have just returned from a detached youth work session based in and around the Leys. We had a number of profitable conversations, and out of them there were 2 recurring topics being raised:

1) An interest in having a climbing wall to use for recreational purposes. One that caught my eye when doing a search was the following:
