Over time dirt, moss or algae can build up on road signs making them unsightly or even obscured.

Working on unclassified roads up to 30mph (and some B roads up to 30mph where there is a pavement) cleaning road signs not only improves the appearance of the Parish but prevents signs from becoming illegible to motorists.

Encouraging residents to take part can turn sign cleaning into an event that strengthens relationships and builds a sense of empowerment throughout the community.
