Costs have increased for 2024. For example, the Club needs to hire road closure barriers which are compliant with current regulations.			
The Club is employing two SIA Security officers to control access through the road closures. In previous years this element has caused heated exchanges with elderly volunteers resourcing the closures.			
The event is attended by 7-8000 residents aged from 0-90, it is the second largest free event of the year. The other is the Witney Carnival which is organised by the Rotary Club, Lions and Air Cadets.
