**Witney Footpath No. 32
Rectification of Anomaly on the Definitive Map**

The County Council is undertaking a review of its Definitive Map and Statement, which is the legal record of public rights of way. Part of this review involves identifying paths that have noticeably been marked incorrectly on the map, including areas where gaps have been left in the network.

One such path issue has come to light, in that there is a gap between the end of the legal line of Footpath No. 32 and the Marlborough Lane, as shown between points A and B on the map in the attached report. The report provides some additional context to this for your information.

In due course, the Council will make and advertise an Order to modify the Map to record the missing section of Footpath No. 32. When this is done, a copy will be sent to all interested parties including the Parish and District Councils and its effect will simply allow the Map to be rectified.
