

FIVEWAYS ROUNDABOUT PROPOSED IMPROVEMENTS

WHAT...

A roundabout with protected and segregated space for all modes: cycling, walking and motorised traffic at Fiveways Roundabout, Witney

WHERE...

Fiveways Roundabout, Witney. Where these 5 arms meet:

- A4095 Tower Hill
- Welch Way
- Corn Street
- A415 Ducklington Lane
- A4095 Curbridge Road

WHY...

A scheme identified in the Witney Local Cycling and Walking Infrastructure Plan (LCWIP) with a feasibility design completed by Milestone, to make a collision hotspot safer for cyclists and to encourage Active Travel in and around Witney

HOW...

Long Term - Once a consultation has been conducted, the proposed improvements can be put forward for funding bids with the design and consultation feedback
Short Term - Vision Zero will be consulting on an “in the meantime” solution.

WHAT'S NEXT...

Engaging with local members and key stakeholders to understand opinions, thoughts and feedback on the initial design and idea of introducing protected and segregated space for cycling at Fiveways Roundabout.
