We work closely with Thames Valley POlicein searching for high risk missing individualsand provide flood and water support to Oxfordshire Fire & Rescue Service. During major incidents, such as natural disasters and during extreme weather, we provide aid to Oxfordshire County Counci. WE are member sof the Thames Valley Resilience Forum and are affiliated to the National Association of Lowland Rescue. Out charity organisation is comprised of 100% volunteers who, as a team, are available 24/7, 365 days a year to search for high risk missing people in our communities.

Purpose for which the grant is required: Approximately 95% of our searches for missing people in Oxfordshire involve water. In the last twelve months we have been called out to search for a missing person approximately 90 times with 8 of those searches being within the town of Witney. We would like to purchase a new water trailer that would provide a number of functions for the team. It would enable to team to use it as a sonar data analysis area, providing a space to sit and review captured data during deployments. In addition, it would be set up as an office and kit hub which could serve as a secondary incident control point. This dual functionality would enhance our operational flexibility and readiness in case of vehicle breakdown or multiple deployments. The water team also believe that having a craft within the trailer to deploy the sonar, without needing to bring a separate boat, would be a huge operational benefit. This would streamline our process and improve efficiency during deployments.
