The purpose of this report is to consider entering into an agreement to allow use of the area at the Country Park & Lake as a training venue for the Oxfordshire Fire and Rescue Service.

Background

Oxfordshire Fire and Rescue service have been looking for a venue to carry out training of personnel in preparation for real life water-based incidents. The Country Park has been the scene of former incidents; allowing this training to take place would allow the Fire & Rescue Service to practice potential scenarios which could prove critical should similar events occur in Witney's waterways.

Current Situation

Officers seek approval from the Committee to enter into discussions with the Fire & Rescue Service to agree a memorandum of agreement for the above use and to obtain all relevant completed risk assessments and ensure insurance is in place.

Impact Assessments

The Town Council has a duty to consider the effects of its decisions, functions and activities on equality, biodiversity, and crime & disorder. Consideration should also be given to effects on the environment, given the Council's Climate Emergency declaration in 2019.

- a) Equality no impact.
- b) Biodiversity no impact.
- c) Crime & Disorder –Green Spaces such as Lakes and Parks can contribute to reducing urban crime by making spaces more inviting. The allowance of the area as a training facility would allow for community engagement with the Fire & Rescue Service and lead to a safer area for residents.
- d) Environment & Climate Emergency –The use of the area could affect the natural environment temporarily while in use.

Risk

In decision making Councillors should give consideration to any risks to the Council and any action it can take to limit or negate its liability.

Along with a memorandum of agreement and confirmation that all risk assessments and insurance are in place, all requirements from the council would be fulfilled.

Social Value

Social value is the positive change the Council creates in the local community within which it operates.

By allowing this training to take place, the Council would be supporting a positive and proactive approach to future incidents in the community.

Financial implications
