**Subject:** Notice of Definitive Map and Statement Legal Event Modification Order 2025

Dear Sir/Madam,

The County Council has just made a Legal Event Modification Order (LEMO) to update the Definitive Map and Statement (DMS). This is essentially an administrative exercise and is not subject to objection. Most Public Path Orders that the County Council makes also have the effect of modifying the DMS at the same time but some Orders and Agreements, including any made by District Councils, do not legally modify the DMS and require this additional procedure. This is an annual housekeeping exercise and this Order includes all those legal events which have either come into operation or came to our attention between 1 January 2023 and 31 December 2024 inclusive.

Attached is a list of the legal events contained within the Order for your information together with an extract from the LEMO showing the changes to the Definitive Statement relevant to your parish. I would emphasise that all the changes included have already taken place on the ground, after the relevant Diversion Orders / Creation Agreements were confirmed / signed / certified as required. Since you should have already received any information about these changes at the time that the relevant Order was made, I am not including a copy of these Order plans. However, please do contact me if you wish to see a copy of any of these Orders or have any queries.
