OXFORDSHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL (WITNEY, DUCKLINGTON LANE) (PROHIBITION OF RIGHT TURN) ORDER 20**

Oxfordshire County Council ("the Council") in exercise of its powers under Sections 1(1), 2(1) & (2) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 ("the Act") and of all other enabling powers, and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act hereby make the following Order.

This Order may be cited as the Oxfordshire County Council (Witney, Ducklington Lane) (Prohibition of Right Turn) Order 20** and shall come into force on the day of 20**.

- 1. Save as provided by article 2 of this Order no person shall, other than under the direction of a police constable in uniform, cause or permit a vehicle to make a right turn northwards onto the A415 Ducklington Lane from (site to be named later) land on the east side of said road between Ducklington roundabout and the A40 overbridge ("the Section of Road").
- 2. Nothing in article 1 to this Order shall render it unlawful for a person to cause or permit a vehicle to enter the Section of Road northwards if the vehicle is being used for Police, fire or ambulance services in an emergency;
