

# Cllr Survey


- Survey developed and issued by Cllrs

- Results are split by the division type i.e. urban, suburban, rural or mixed.









# Summary of key findings

- Largest issue for Divisions
  - Inadequate cycling facilities (68%)
  - Traffic speeding (59%)
  - Parking enforcement (55%)
- <u>Division priority measures</u>
  - School Streets (57%)
  - 20 mph limits (52%)
  - Additional cycle facilities (45%) + Pop up cycle facilities with physical separation from traffic (39%) \*
  - \* Additional cycle facilities = Optimisation of existing facilities, additional cycle racks, communal bike pumps

Pop up cycle facilities = New routes wanted/ discussed
