Owing to Covid-19, the Sqn has been unable to conduct any fundraising through 2020, and the last fundraising event was held in August 2019. Our last audited accounts will show we have always been successful in raising funds without requiring us to submit grant applications. In 2021, the sqn staff volunteers and parents will be assisting at local events such as Carnival, the advent fete but do not expect to receive any finances in return, but wish to ensure that free community events continue to take place after such a difficult period of time. At the time of application, cadets may resume training but are prohibited from supporting public events until further easing of restrictions and the National Youth Agency alert reducing to 'NYA Green'; based on the Government roadmap, this is part of Step 4 ('not earlier than 21 June 21').

We do not receive any funding or grants from the Royal Air Force and our activities (excluding flying/gliding which are paid for by HQ Air Cadets) are entirely self-sufficient.
