What are the activities and/or aims of the organisation?

Our vision is to create an empowering platform and space for anyone, regardless of age and experience, to explore their own voice and creativity within a safe and inclusive environment.

Our mission is to provide a relaxed and attentive environment for training in the performing arts through professional workshops for adults and young people, offering our students a greater sense of self-confidence, self-acceptance and community.

Our values ensure that with equality and compassion, everyone has the opportunity to attain their goals.

Our classes

We offer a wide range of professional performing arts workshops for both adults and young people, run and taught by our skilled team of industry professionals in Theatre, Film, Dance and Vocal Performance Training. Our aim is to provide a relaxed and attentive environment for their performing arts training.

In our fun-filled sessions, our students could be working on perfecting their performance skills and technique for the stage and screen, working on technical 'behind-the-scenes' aspects of performing arts, such as designing costumes, props, programmes, scripts, learning how to direct!

During their time with us, we'll help to build their self-confidence, nurture their self-esteem and mental health. They will be given the opportunity to develop life skills such as communication, problem solving, perseverance, teamwork and accountability.

Our Youth Theatre

Our sessions are tailored to work through different genres to develop and enhance creativity such as improvisation, development of characters, script work, working with puppets, vocal and singing. We aim to boost confidence and self esteem, nurture hidden talents, aid in the development of life skills and performance techniques.

Acting for Film & TV – Youth

Know how to act in front of a camera, learn the skills needed for screen acting. Through fun exercises, improvisations and script work, we'll explore what makes a compelling and truthful screen performance. We teach you all the techniques of acting in front of the camera and what happens behind the camera. Our students have the chance to star in their own film and if they would like to further their career in the acting field, we can offer the possibility of joining a professional acting agency.

Musical Theatre – Dance sessions - Youth

Whether our students enjoy singing along to Disney in the car or shimmying to their favourite show tunes, our Musical Theatre Workshops offers the chance to learn some of the actual routines from some of the West End and Broadway hits. Aimed at all levels of performance experience, the workshops aim to give a taste of performing as a 'Swing' in some of the most well-known show dances. Shows include West Side Story, Legally Blonde, Mary Poppins, Hairspray and Wicked.

Supporting Mental Health

We create exercises using what we call strength exercises as part of our sessions. These will hopefully help each person struggling with different elements of mental health needs to recognise their struggles and give them resources to use. An example of this would be a young teenager who is on the autistic spectrum who calls herself 'weird.' We turn this round into a positive and through different types of drama exercises help her to develop and show she's not 'weird.' We use positivity and group acceptance. We also offer the opportunity to students who feel they are struggling in life and would like to talk on a one to one basis confidentially.
