Title: Tennis Courts at West Witney – Colour Coating

Background

The four tennis courts at West Witney Sports Ground are colour-coated approximately every 5-7 years and this is now due. The project has been included in the forthcoming year's budget and there is an earmarked reserve, including S106 funds also available. Last year officers also obtained quotes for the MUGAs to have their lining refreshed – it has since been noted that these are included in the grounds maintenance contract and will be re lined in March this year.

Current Situation

The Project Officer has obtained three quotations for the work to be carried out – as attached to this report.

Environmental impact

Having declared a Climate Change Emergency at its Council meeting on 26 June 2019 – with this in mind Councillors should have due regard to the environmental impact of any decisions they make with regard to its facilities and services it operates.

There are no environmental concerns associated with this project.

Risk

In decision making Councillors should give consideration to any risks to the Council and any action it can take to limit or negate its liability.

Financial implications

The Quotations are as follows:

- Quote 1 – total of £7,100 plus VAT
- Quote 2 – total of £6,7800 plus VAT
- Quote 3 – total of £13,302 (not VAT registered)

The budget for colour-coating the courts at West Witney Sports Ground from 1st April 2022 is £10,000 (4921/800). Additional funding could be used from EMR line 319.
